## PLEASE READ

### Rules and Regulations: Golf Course

ALLOWED



ALLOWED

- Range balls are only to be used on the range. They are not to be brought onto the golf course.
- All Play shall start from first tee unless otherwise directed by the Golf Shoppe personnel.
- All members and guests shall register in the Golf Shoppe prior to beginning play. All charges must be taken care of before play starts.
- Specific approval from the golf shop is required to start on any tee other than number one. "Cutting-in" is not permitted at any time.
- The golf course superintendent is authorized to determine when the golf course is suitable for play. The decision of the Superintendent and/or the Golf Professional on duty shall make the decision
- Postings regarding the golf course condition or regulations must be adhered to without exception.
- The Golf Shoppe staff may clear the golf course at their discretion.
- **There shall be no outside beverages allowed on the course at any time. Anyone violating this rule shall receive a warning and the second violation may result in suspended golf privileges. This is against club policy.**
- All members and guests must have proper attire to proceed onto the golf course.
- Men- collared shirt, golf pants or shorts of respectable length (no denim), **we prefer no cargo, but understand that cargo shorts and pants are in style, must be neat in appearance.** Golf shoes with soft spikes or tennis shoes are required.
- Women- collared or golf intended top, golf pants or shorts (no denim)of respectable length, **we prefer no cargo, but understand that cargo shorts and pants are in style, must be neat in appearance.** Golf shoes with soft spikes or tennis shoes are required.
- Foursomes will dictate the pace of the play.
- Practice is not allowed on the golf course unless the practice is result of a playing lesson being given by one of the Golf Professionals.
- All golfers must have their own set of clubs.
- Fivesomes will be prohibited unless given previous permission by the Golf Professional Staff.
- Fishing in the ponds off #4 and #16 is not permitted. Fishing must end 30 minutes before sunset. Parking must be in the club parking lot.
