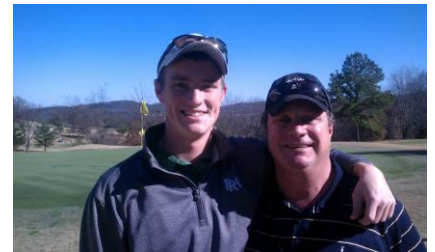

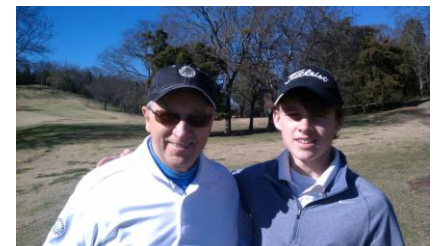

News from the course

November and Thanksgiving have certainly passed by quickly, but not without leaving behind some really nice golfing weather. That weather was also great for the maintenance as well, allowing us to get a jump on some pressing projects that were on our agenda. I would like to give an update and status of what we will be busy on the upcoming month.

Tree work: We have removed trees on 6 tee and 9 green, and also a few small ones on 2, 11, 13, 12, 5, 7. In addition, many limbs have been trimmed up to a more manageable height. We will continue to work on trees throughout the entire off season. Plans for planting replacement trees have been discussed and will be implemented this winter. Stumps will be ground down as well.

Cart Path work: Cart path repair has been taking place, with poured concrete on #12, and numerous spot repairs with either asphalt or back fill. Other areas to pour concrete are by # 8 tee and behind #12 green. Continued repair will go on through out the winter.

Bunker work: Because sand traps play a tremendous part of this layout, a concise effort has been implemented to improve the playability and uniformity of all bunkers. Numerous traps have either have had sand added, roto-tilled, or sand repositioned. We will continue to monitor bunker conditions and act swiftly and accordingly.
